

Hall of Fame for Northern Laguna Chapter

It's another first for Northern Laguna Chapter (NLC).....after receiving its fourth consecutive Most Outstanding Chapter Award (Big Chapter Category), NLC received the first ever Hall of Fame Award given by the Institute last November 7, 2009 during the Closing Ceremony of the 34th Annual National Convention at SMX, Mall of Asia. As explained by 2008 National President Hipolito Leoncio during the awarding ceremony, NLC will be exempted from the selection of Most Outstanding Chapters for two years to give chance to other chapters vying for the annual award. Hall of Fame will be given to a chapter who can win the award for three times consecutively.

Officially approved as a chapter last February 19, 2005, the chapter only on its fifth year of operation made history by garnering four (4) Most Outstanding Chapter Awards.

The quest for Chapter Development Excellence started when Engr. Larry C. Cruz challenged his team members to achieve the best chapter award during his induction as the chapter's first President on April 22, 2005.

The challenge was seriously taken by the NLC Officers and on its second year, the chapter received its first ever most outstanding award under the leadership of 2006 NLC President Dennis Saavedra and right after the awarding ceremony on November 2006, Engr. John Eduard Bautista, the 2007 Chapter President declared the chapter's goal, the now famous among NLC members, "Go for Three"

“Go for Three” aims to duplicate the first award for three consecutive years and with the strong commitment and leadership of the NLC Officers and the support from its members, the Chapter received its second award during the 32nd IIEE Annual National Convention under the leadership

of Engr. Bautista and its third award during the 33rd IIEE Annual National Convention under the leadership of 2008 NLC President Jozane Jalbuena.

After achieving it's goal, the NLC officers during their annual planning session for 2009 realizes the impact that it has created in winning the three awards, there is something more than just winning awards, the chapter must help IIEE in promoting excellence in membership and chapter development, thus the goal "living a legacy" was formulated. Best practices of NLC will be shared to other chapters for them to study and adopt if applicable and necessary for them. They started the sharing activities to other chapters in Region IV during the February edition of the 2009 Journey to Unity (J2U) hosted by NLC at University of Perpetual Help System, Biñan, Laguna.

Under the leadership of 2009 NLC President Generoso Restubog, big and important activities on the areas of technical, students, education, civic programs and membership were excellently done the whole year of 2009 and the efforts of the officers was rewarded with the fourth award.
